

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF AN OPIOID OVERDOSE

-  Dizziness and confusion
-  Body weakness
-  Sleepiness
-  Slow Breathing
-  Slow heart rate
-  Pinpoint Pupils
-  Face is pale and/or feels cold
-  Unconsciousness
-  Vomiting or making gurgling noise
-  Slow or no responsiveness

DIRECTIONS



Step 1: Check for responsiveness



Step 2: Call 911



Step 3: Roll onto back



Step 4: Gently check for responsiveness



Step 5: Open Narcan package

Step 6: Place tip fully into one nostril

Step 7: Push in plunger

Step 8: Place in recovery position
