## UNTHSC College of Public Health MHA – Master of Healthcare Administration

The Master of Healthcare Administration (MHA) Cohort program is a 54-semester credit hour program guided by the UNTHSC MHA Competency Model which addresses the complexity and dynamic qualities of the health leader's role and reflects the realities in health leadership today. Students in the MHA program are admitted once a year as a cohort. Full-time enrollment is required with the expectation of graduation in five consecutive semesters. Students follow a weekly calendar of activity that occupies 9-hour blocks of time, Monday to Friday (9am-6pm).

The program is designed to prepare full-time students for healthcare management positions in settings such as: hospitals, managed care organizations, medical group practices, ambulatory or long-term care settings, insurance agencies, pharmaceutical companies, consulting firms, government agencies, for-profit and nonprofit sector organizations. The preparation includes the completion of a full-time internship in an approved health services organization under the guidance of a qualified preceptor. The purpose of this internship is to provide the student with "real world" experience in which to apply concepts and models learned in the classroom.
