This form is to be used to notify the IBC of use at the HSC campus of non-hazardous animal samples and storage only of biological material. This form should be used by laboratories that only use non-Hazardous animal samples, if hazardous animal samples are used then an IBC protocol needs to be submitted to cover all samples used in the laboratory.

This form should be used for storage of biological samples that are not currently handled in the laboratory. If those samples are removed from storage for use, then an IBC protocol needs to be submitted prior to use.

Definitions:

Non-hazardous animal samples are any tissues, organ, carcasses, bodily fluids, or feces from animal studies excluding NHPs in which the animals have not be exposed to recombinant material, infectious agents, toxins, prions, chemicals or radioisotopes.

Storage only of biological samples, these are animal samples, human samples, recombinant material, infectious agents, toxins, or prions from previous experiments that are not currently being used and are placed in long term storage.
